10. Appointment - Building Inspectors

BE IT RESOLVED that the Municipal Council of Memramcook appoint the above-named Inspectors as Building Inspectors for the Village de Memramcook under Section 71 of the *Local Governance Act*;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Village de Memramcook hereby gives authority to the Building Inspectors to issue orders and to lay information for offences under Section 14 of the *Building Code Administration Act*.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the above appointment shall continue as long as the person is employed or retained by the Village de Memramcook.

14. Update - Water Damage to the Municipal Building

The Director of Finance provides an update on the damages caused by a water break during extreme cold weather on February 4th and 5th at the Municipal Building. The damage has left the entire building non-functional. Steps are being taken with the insurer to determine the extent of the situation and the steps that will follow. The necessary work is also underway for the clean-up. It is suggested to compare options between restoring the building and rebuilding from scratch. The employees are operating from the Eugène (Gene) LeBlanc Arena while library employees will be working out of other libraries until further notice.
