Call to Order

Mayor Maxime O. Bourgeois calls the meeting to order at 7:03 p.m.

Acknowledgement of Unceded Traditional Territory

The mayor recognizes the unceded traditional territory.

Confirmation of Quorum by the Clerk

The clerk confirms that a quorum has been established.

4. Declaration of Conflict of Interest

Coucillor Carole Duguay declares a conflict of interest for part of item 17. Section 68(1)(j) of the Local Governance Act – labour and employment matters, including the negotiation of collective agreements. Mayor Maxime O. Bourgeois declares a conflict of interest for item 16. Section 68(1)(c) of the Local Governance Act – information that could cause financial loss or gain to a person or the local government or could jeopardize negotiations leading to an agreement or contract and Section 68(1)(d) of the Local Governance Act – the proposed or pending acquisition or disposition of land.
