6. Presentation - New Extended Producer Responsibility Program for Packaging and Printer Paper

Sébastian Hultberg and Patrick Langis of the SERSC present details of a new recycling program in New Brunswick. The program consists of recycling materials related to printed paper and packaging, and extended producer responsibility. Circular Materials, a non-profit organization responsible for implementing effective recycling programs, represents many leading manufacturers and retailers in the country. It is funded by the industry and is responsible for the collection, processing and market research of various recyclable materials, namely the materials in blue bags.

By joining the program, the municipality would become a service provider for blue bag collection and receive a subsidy for each residence. If the municipality declines, Circular Materials will become responsible for blue bag collection and management. This program aims at creating an equal plane for all regions in the province. The risk of fines to the municipality for product contamination is discussed.

For the Memramcook area, the membership period would begin in May 2024 and end in 2027. If the municipality joins the program, the SERSC would be responsible for the education, awareness and promotion among residents. The municipality has until December 18th to join the program.
