6. Presentations, Request and Petitions

a) Presentation - Pro-Jeunesse

Mr. Tristian Gaudet provides an update on Pro Jeunesse's strategic plan. He shares some statistics and the results of a study. In the past, the organization had at its disposal the services of a City of Dieppe employee. Since her retirement, the organization has had to reformulate the way it operates. A potential solution is to create a full-time position for a general manager. Among its other objectives, the organization also proposes to improve its branding, create a communication and awareness plan, and develop new strategies to increase funding. The group is therefore asking the Municipal Council to increase its annual contribution.

b) Discussions with Plan360 Regarding Tourist Accommodations

Phil Robichaud and Florent Vallade of Plan360 present a report on methods for administering and controlling tourist accommodations in Memramcook. Currently, the municipality's Rural Plan prescribes a rezoning process to consider applications for the development of tourist accommodations on its territory. A summary of current practices in neighbouring municipalities is presented. It is recommended by the SERSC that the municipality's rural plan be amended so that the development of such projects would take place without the usual rezoning process for RD zones, but rather that the authority would rest with the SERSC's Planning Review and Adjustment Committee. The consensus of the Council is to mandate the SERSC to proceed with the process of amending the Rural Plan, which consists of public hearings, as well as a meeting with the Planning Review and Adjustment Committee to also hold a minimum of three Council meetings to treat the matter.
