f) Motion in Support of Rail Safety Week

WHEREAS Rail Safety Week will be held in Canada from September 18th to September 24th, 2023.

WHEREAS 232 crossing and trespassing incidents occurred in Canada in 2022, resulting in 66 preventable fatalities and 43 serious injuries.

WHEREAS educating and informing the public about rail safety (by reminding the public that rail rights-of-way are private property, by raising awareness on the dangers associated with level crossings, by ensuring that pedestrians and motorists are alert and attentive around railroads and respect traffic regulations) will reduce the number of preventable deaths and injuries caused by incidents involving trains and citizens.

WEREAS Operation Lifesaver is a public/private partnership whose aim is to work with the public, the rail industry, governments, police services, the media and other organizations to raise rail safety awareness.

WHEREAS CN is asking the Municipal Council to adopt this motion in support of its ongoing efforts to raise awareness, save lives and prevent injuries in communities, including our municipality.

THEREFORE, be it resolved to support National Rail Safety Week from September 18th to the 24th, 2023.

g) Proclamation – Fetal Alcohol Spectrum Disorder Awareness Month Moved by Carole Duguay Seconded by Normand Dupuis

WHEREAS Fetal Alcohol Spectrum Disorder (FASD) is a diagnostic term used to describe impacts on the brain and body of individuals prenatally exposed to alcohol. FASD is a lifelong disability. Individuals with FASD will experience some degree of challenges in their daily living, and need support with motor skills, physical health, learning, memory, attention, communication, emotional regulation, and social skills to reach their full potential. Each individual with FASD is unique and has areas of both strengths and challenges.

WHEREAS fasdNL is a pan-provincial organization that educates, provides supports and resources, and raises awareness about fetal alcohol spectrum disorder (FASD) in Newfoundland and Labrador and Atlantic Canada; and

WHEREAS fasdNL is leading a three-year FASD prevention, awareness, training and collaborative action project in the four Atlantic provinces; and

WHEREAS FASD Awareness month is devoted to raising awareness of Fetal Alcohol Spectrum Disorder (FASD) to improve prevention of FASD and diagnosis and support for individuals with FASD and broad public awareness helps to put FASD on the "map";

THEREFORE, I, Maxime O. Bourgeois, Mayor for the Village de Memramcook, do hereby proclaim the month of September 2023 to be FASD Awareness Month in the Village de Memramcook.
