#### b) Changes to the 911 Dispatch System Moved by Mariane Cullen

WHEREAS Council has serious concerns regarding the recent changes to the 911 dispatch system;

WHERAS Council wishes to express its dissatisfaction regarding these changes;

WHEREAS the Memramcook Fire Department is trained and equipped to respond to medical emergencies and has been doing so for 33 years;

WHERAS the Village de Memramcook does not have an ambulance service within the municipality;

WHERAS the Village de Memramcook is in a rural and remote area from existing ambulance services;

WHERAS Ambulance NB's response time for our municipality often exceeds provincial standards and that even the prescribed 22-minute response time is long during an emergency;

WHERAS the Village de Memramcook is concerned that its territory does not have full cellular reception and believes the radio system remains the best option;

WHERAS Council is concerned for the safety and well-being of its residents if this situation is not addressed in a timely manner;

BE IT RESOLVED THAT Municipal Council urges the responsible authorities to immediately correct this critical situation endangering the safety of residents and that the Memramcook Fire Department be again called for medical calls on its territory, as it was before;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED to make a formal request to Ambulance NB for an ambulance in Memramcook.
